It is optional to enter either or both but you will only jump one round and the score will go to either or both sections (plus jump off if applicable)

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 148cms – Riders 16 and under on 1 January in current year.
PONY NOT TO HAVE WON A FIRST PRIZE IN ANY BS COMPETITION ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW.

Class 3.4 (a) **Club Junior Intermediate : Not exceeding 80cms in first round.**

This is combined with

(b) **80cms CashJumping class.**

In order to enter this section you need to be registered with “CashJumping”.

You may enter one section or both sections but must pay two lots of entry fees to enter both sections and, therefore, be eligible for two lots of prizes (ordinary Club, rosettes and prize money and CashJumping rosettes and prize money. It is optional to enter either or both but you will only jump one round and the score will go to either or both sections (plus jump off if applicable)

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 148cms – Riders 16 and under on 1 January in current year.

Class 3.5 **Junior Open : Not exceeding 90cms in first round.**

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 148cms – Riders 16 and under on 1 January in current year.

Class 3.6 **Senior Pre-Novice : Not exceeding 60cms in first round.**

(b) **70cms CashJumping class.**

In order to enter this section you need to be registered with “CashJumping”.

You may enter one section or both sections but must pay two lots of entry fees to enter both sections and, therefore, be eligible for two lots of prizes (ordinary Club, rosettes and prize money and CashJumping rosettes and prize money. It is optional to enter either or both but you will only jump one round and the score will go to either or both sections (plus jump off if applicable)

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms – Riders any age. **HORSE NOT TO HAVE WON A FIRST PRIZE IN ANY BSJA COMPETITION ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW**

Class 3.8 (a) **Club Senior Intermediate : Not exceeding 80cms in first round.**

This is combined with

(b) **80cms CashJumping class.**

In order to enter this section you need to be registered with “CashJumping”.

You may enter one section or both sections but must pay two lots of entry fees to enter both sections and, therefore, be eligible for two lots of prizes (ordinary Club, rosettes and prize money and CashJumping rosettes and prize money. It is optional to enter either or both but you will only jump one round and the score will go to either or both sections (plus jump off if applicable)

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms – Riders any age.

Class 3.9 **Senior Open : Not exceeding 90cms in first round.**

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms – Riders any age.

NOTES:

1: **ADULT RIDERS WISHING TO JUMP A PONY, MAY DO SO, PROVIDED THEY HAVE NOMINATED THEIR PONY TO JUMP AS A HORSE AND IT DOES NOT JUMP AS A PONY IN THE JUNIOR SECTION ON THAT DAY.**

2: **Junior Section**
Any pony which enters class 3.5 is NOT ABLE to enter classes 3.1 or 3.2

Senior Section
Riders may only enter three of the four classes i.e. CANNOT enter both 3.6 and 3.9

3: **CashJumping**
These classes are designed to pay out more cash in prize money than normal classes. £5 of entry fee of £10 goes into the prize money pot and is then divided among the prize winners. More entries – more prize money!

Please see CashJumping website for rules and prize money grid and be aware you need to be registered with CashJumping to take part. It only costs £109 to register so why not have a go

You need to be able to produce your CashJumping registration number to enter.

In all classes below for May and June shows - the highest placed animal 15 years and over will qualify for the Senior Showing and Dressage Limited Summer Championship Show on Sunday 29 June 2014 at Onley Grounds, Rugby.

ALSO Classes 4.3(A) and 4.4 for May and June only are Olympia First Round Showing qualifiers for 2014. Qualifying cards will be handed out which entitles the competitors to enter Olympia Section Round qualifiers. (See wording later in schedule)

- Class 4.1 **In-hand young stock aged 3 years and under** – Handlers must be competent enough to handle their ponies/horses without assistance.
(06 May and 09 June : Equestrian Life Qualifier)
- Class 4.2 **Open In-hand for animals NOT EXCEEDING 148CMS** – Handlers must be competent enough to handle their ponies/horses without assistance.
(05 May & 08 June : Equestrian Life Qualifier)
- Class 4.3 **Open In-hand for animals EXCEEDING 148cms** – Handlers must be competent enough to handle their ponies/horses without assistance.
(05 May & 08 June : Equestrian Life Qualifier)
- Class 4.3(A) *** Senior Pony/Horse In-hand for animals 15 years and over.**
(06 May and 09 June ONLY)
 1: **Pre-Senior In-hand – horse or pony 15 – 18 years old**
 2: **Senior in-hand – horse or pony 19 – 23 years old**
 3: **Senior-Plus in-hand – horse or pony 24 years old and over**
- Class 4.4 ***Ridden Senior Pony/Horse** : For animals aged 15 years and over – Riders any age. Held at all shows.
(05 May & 08 June : Equestrian Life Qualifier and SSADL Qualifiers)
 1: **Pre-Senior Ridden – horse or pony 15 – 18 years old**
 2: **Senior Ridden – horse or pony 19 – 23 years old**
 3: **Senior-Plus Ridden – horse or pony 24 years old and over**
- Class 4.5 **Ridden M&M (SMALL BREEDS)** : Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Sections A and B
(05 May & 08 June : Equestrian Life Qualifier)
- Class 4.6 **Ridden M&M (LARGE BREEDS)** : Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Welsh Sections C and D
(05 May & 08 June : Equestrian Life Qualifier)
- Class 4.7 **Ridden Coloured** – Open to **ALL** true coloured Piebald, Skewbald and Appaloosa
(05 May & 08 June : Equestrian Life Qualifier)
- Class 4.8 **Best Ridden Family Horse/Pony.**
To be judged on suitability for a family shared horse/pony.
(05 May & 08 June : Equestrian Life Qualifier)

Stallions and Foals at Foot are admitted subject to prior acceptance by Barleyfields Riding Club or Barleyfields Equestrian Centre and/or behaviour on the day. If poor and/or unsafe behaviour is exhibited the handler and/or owner will be asked to remove said animal(s) from the showground.

***The following applies to classes 4.3(A) and 4.4**

No foals, spurs, galloping or wearing of face/body jewellery permitted. Foals are not permitted in SSADL classes. Minimum age of handler for In-hand classes – 9 years. For stallions in-hand and ridden, competitors must be over 16 years of age. Competitors cannot enter the ring once the command of trot has been given. The same rider combination must stay the same from first/second round qualifiers and the grand final.

All competitors should acquaint themselves with SSAD (Senior Showing and Dressage Limited) Rules before entering. They can be found at www.seniorshowinganddressage.co.uk.

The Olympia Anthony Evans SSADL First Round Qualifiers are open to both Affiliated and Unaffiliated Riders and Handlers of the Senior Showing and Dressage Limited. The SSADL rulebook can be found at www.seniorshowinganddressage.co.uk

First to Third in each class will receive a £10.00 voucher kindly sponsored by Anthony Evans Insurance. Qualification Cards will be handed out in the ring at the time of presentation.

Competitors only need one Qualification Card for In-hand classes and one qualification card for Ridden classes. If already qualified this card must be handed down the line

The next stage – Second Round qualifiers: You can only compete in the Olympia Anthony Evans SSADL Second Round Qualifiers if you are a 2014 affiliated rider/handler and your animal is registered with SSAD Limited and hold the 2014 member/registration card. Once you have qualified at a First Round Qualifier and you have received an **Acceptance Card**, only then may you compete in the Second Round Qualifier. The Second Round **Champions** will go on to compete at the Olympia Anthony Evans SSAD Limited Championship Supreme Final at the London International Horse Show at Olympia in December 2014.

Dressage Riders can qualify, by achieving 58% or more, for the Dressage Championships of Great Britain to be held at the David Broome Event Centre in Wales – horse/rider must be unaffiliated to qualify.

Dressage riders must become members of the Club if they wish to compete. However, a “Dressage Day Membership” is £3.00 EXTRA per class per show in addition to the Class entry fee of £10.00. The Dressage Secretary MUST receive your membership number OR the day membership fee at the time of entry otherwise **YOUR ENTRY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

There is an extra class within each of our classes – please mark your entry if you wish to be considered for the Senior Pony/Horse Section (Horse 15+) to qualify for the Senior Pony/Horse Dressage Championships.

ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED STRICTLY BY WEDNESDAY PRIOR TO EACH SHOW WITH THE CORRECT ENTRY FEE – THERE ARE NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY FOR DRESSAGE.

- 1: There will be **NO REFUND OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY REASON.**
- 2: Any objections must be placed with the Secretary, in writing, accompanied by a fee of £10.00, within **FIFTEEN MINUTES** of the end of the relevant class. This fee will be returned if the objection is upheld.
- 3: See **SEPARATE SCHEDULE/ENTRY FORM FOR DRESSAGE CLASSES 5.1, 5.2, 5.3, 5.4, 5.5, 5.6, 5.7 AND 5.8.**
- 4: **Pony Showjumping Classes will commence at 9.00 a.m. with Clear Round followed at 9.30 with class 3.1 with Horse Showjumping classes and Clear Round (classes 5.6 to 5.9 NOT BEFORE 12 NOON.**
- 5: PRIZE MONEY to third place (according to entries, i.e. minimum of 3 entries for first prize, 6-10 entries for second prize, 11-15 entries for third prize) and rosettes to sixth.
- 6: The additional Rules pertaining to the Equestrian Life Qualification classes on 05 May & 08 June ONLY are in the box above and should be read before entering those relevant classes which are separately shown, also in boxes.
- 7: **05 MAY AND 08 JUNE ONLY**

- 13: Any horse/pony behaving in an unfit manner in collecting rings will be asked to leave.
- 14: **Dogs to be kept under control and on a lead at all times.**
- 15: **DO NOT THROW LITTER ABOUT THESE PREMISES – LITTER BINS ARE PROVIDED. EQUESTRIAN CENTRE ANIMALS MAY PICK UP AND SWALLOW LITTER LEFT IN FIELDS.**
